NGC on alleged break in gas transmission

The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (NGC) would like to clarify a statement made in a Daily Express article, 'Gas breakdown causes black out across T&T'.

The article, which appeared on page 3, May 12th 2016 of the newspaper, stated that, "A break in transmission of natural gas from the National Gas Company (NGC) to the Trinidad Generation Unlimited (TGU) power plant in La Brea triggered a black-out in several parts of the country yesterday."

NGC wishes to formally state that the power outage which occurred on May 11th 2016, was as a consequence of a break in the instrumentation at the TGU facility. The NGC provided an uninterrupted supply of gas to TGU.
