The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (NGC) is proud to support a Music Literacy Programme in which three promising steelbands are enrolled – Gonzales Sheikers Steel Orchestra which started on the road to music literacy in June, NGC Couva Joylanders and NGC La Brea Nightingales which followed in August. Since the company also sponsors police youth clubs in Couva and La Brea, and supports community interaction and cohesiveness, members of the youth clubs were also invited to enrol.

The music literacy programme seeks to help develop a formal understanding of musical structure and rhythms so that instead of just “beating pan”, members will be able to read sheet music and play a musical instrument. It will run for four months in Couva and Gonzales and five months in La Brea.

A combined 83 persons from Couva, La Brea and Gonzales will experience the exciting world of music literacy and the many possibilities it opens up.
