On October 5 NGC experienced a reduction in gas supply from one of its suppliers. The supplier has indicated that a process upset at one of its facilities required it to restrict production from its offshore platforms.

NGC was able to make up part of the resulting gas shortage by increasing its take from its other suppliers and has managed the residual shortfall by reducing its gas supply to its large industrial consumers.

NGC has not reduced the amount of gas supplied to T&TEC in accordance with its standard policy that gas supply for power generation is given highest priority. T&TEC has advised that they did not need to shed load and the general public has not been affected.

All parties are working together to normalize the situation as soon as possible.
