Additional COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) Information for Update #506

The Ministry of Health provides the following additional information:

- 76 additional persons have tested positive for COVID -19
These new 76 new patients will be processed for admission at the discretion of the CMOHs.

Out of the 76 new COVID-19 positive cases, 24 of these came from one source, the prison population in Tobago.

- 10 persons have been discharged from public health facilities
- There have been 56 recovered community cases
Recovered community cases refer to persons who were previously COVID-19 positive and in self-isolation at home and subsequently met the discharge criteria and were released from self-isolation.
- The Ministry of Health regrets to inform the public that **there have been 2 additional COVID-19 related deaths**. One person is an elderly female and the other is a middle-aged male, both with pre-existing conditions. This brings the total number of COVID-19 related deaths to 86.
