Additional COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) Information for Update #514

The Ministry of Health provides the following additional information:

- 47 additional persons have tested positive for COVID -19
These new patients will be processed for admission at the discretion of the CMOHs.
- 7 persons have been discharged from public health facilities.
- There have been 36 recovered community cases.
Recovered community cases refer to persons who were previously COVID-19 positive and in self-isolation at home and subsequently met the discharge criteria and were released from self-isolation.
- The Ministry of Health regrets to inform the public that there have been two (2) additional COVID-19 related deaths. The persons are an elderly male and a female, both with pre-existing medical conditions. This brings the total number of COVID-19 related deaths to 95.
