### **Additional COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) Information for Update #515**

The Ministry of Health provides the following additional information:

- 40 additional persons have tested positive for COVID -19  
These new patients will be processed for admission at the discretion of the CMOHs.
- 7 persons have been discharged from public health facilities.
- There have been 32 recovered community cases.  
Recovered community cases refer to persons who were previously COVID-19 positive and in self-isolation at home and subsequently met the discharge criteria and were released from self-isolation.
