Additional COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) Information for Update #529

The Ministry of Health provides the following additional information:

- 24 additional persons have tested positive for COVID -19
These new patients will be processed for admission at the discretion of the CMOHs.
- 3 persons have been discharged from public health facilities.
- There have been 152 recovered community cases.
Recovered community cases refer to persons who were previously COVID-19 positive and in self-isolation at home and subsequently met the discharge criteria and were released from self-isolation.
- The Ministry of Health regrets to inform the public that there has been an additional COVID-19 related death. The person is an elderly male with co-morbidities. This brings the total number of COVID-19 related deaths to 108.
