Construction of Natural Gas Service Main in Tamana

The National Gas Company (NGC) wishes to advise the public of planned construction of a natural gas service main at Tamana, Cumuto.

Works will commence shortly and will comprise:

- Construction and laying of a 6" diameter, 3km long natural gas pipeline eastward along the Government Railway Reserve and northward along Cumuto Main Road to the south entrance of Tamana In-Tech Park;
- Construction and laying of 6", 4" and 2" diameter natural gas distribution pipelines within Tamana In-Tech Park.

Construction will run for approximately three months commencing July 2009.

Construction activities will include transportation to site of lengths of pipe, trenching, welding, pipe-laying, hydro-static testing and site restoration.

The open cut trenching method will be used to install the pipe along most of the route and Horizontal Directional Drilling will be used in other areas to minimise inconvenience.

NGC will update you via the media, flyers and loudspeaker announcements in advance of any activity that is likely to impact your everyday activities.

NGC wishes to assure the public that this project, as with all its operations, will be conducted with your safety as our highest priority and every effort will be made to minimise any inconvenience to you.
