# Odorizing For Your Safety:

if you're indoors, your nose will alert you to a natural gas leak.

## Natural Gas keeps our country moving forward.

Gas leaks may occur on rare occasions when you are in a mall, school or other large building. If you are indoors, your nose is your best guide. NGC has added a harmless, smelly substance called mercaptan to the natural gas supply at many locations. If you detect the smell of rotten eggs, there may be a gas leak.

**In that case, you must take the following steps immediately for everyone's safety:**

- Open up all the doors and windows
- Cover your nose with a damp towel or napkin
- Leave the area ON FOOT and move to an open space
- Warn others
- Don't use cell phones or land lines until you are upwind of the area and no longer detect the smell
- Don't use matches, flashlights or anything that can spark
- Don't start vehicles
- Don't smoke
- Don't turn any lights on or off
- Call NGC's 24-hour Emergency Hotline 800-4427 and give details and your location
- Don't return to the area until you are given the all-clear by NGC and Officials of the Fire Services
