Temporary closure of Melbourne Street

The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (NGC) wishes to advise motorists, residents and businesses along Melbourne Street, between Sydney and Charles Streets, Port of Spain, of traffic restrictions to perform pipeline construction works. Controlled pedestrian traffic will be allowed.

There will be a temporary closure of Melbourne Street where it intersects with both Sydney and Charles Streets from:

6am to Sunday 6th
June, 6pm.**

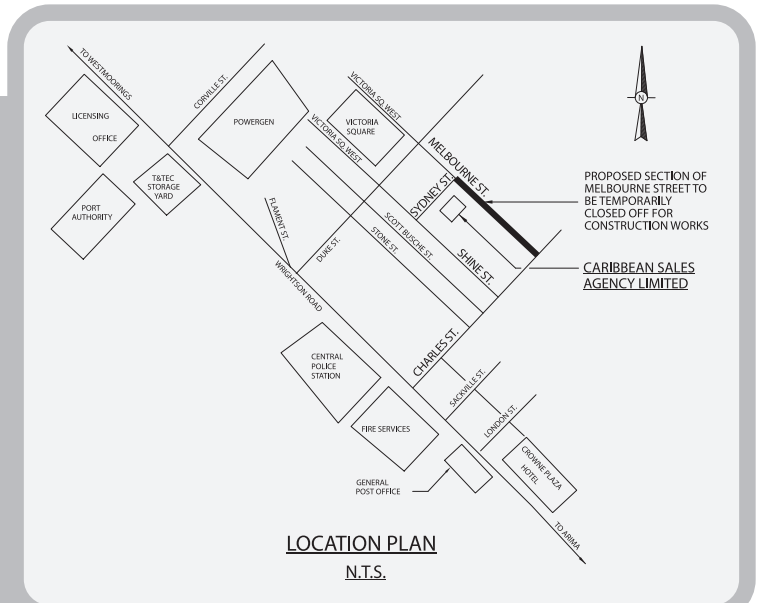
Detour signs will be installed at the intersections of the following streets:

- Melbourne and Charles Streets
- Melbourne and Sydney Streets
- Melbourne and Duke Streets
- Melbourne and Shine Streets

Police officers will be present for traffic diversion arrangements and support.

Motorists and pedestrians wishing to access Duke Street via Melbourne Street shall do so via Shine Street.

Appropriate signage will be installed to warn the public of works in progress at strategic locations.
