

NGC trains CAER teachers

As NGC wrapped up the final phase of last year's Schools Community Awareness and Emergency Response (CAER) Programme, the participating five schools from 2008 were invited to send teachers to a three-day long training workshop. Three of the schools opted to participate.

On the 22nd, 23rd and 25th of September, eleven teachers were trained in First Aid, Emergency Response and Fire-Fighting. This type of training represented the final phase of the 2008 Schools CAER programme, the objective of which is to support the crisis management units in schools that adjoin NGC's natural gas facilities.
